## VERBATIM INSTRUCTIONS TO PARTICIPANTS

"Hello, my name is Elmarie and this is Elaine and that is Yasmin. We work at the Centre for AAC on campus and we work primarily with people who have little or no functional speech. That means that they have less than 15 words that they can use functionally. If you consider that young adults, like yourselves, have between 20,000 and 22,000 words in your vocabulary, you can imagine that 15 words does not go a very long way when you're trying to communicate your thoughts about the world. There are existing software packages that were developed for people with little or no functional speech, that are based on pictures.
