How? By measuring population health and movement as well as social and economic status in Atteridgeville and Melusi over many years, we can identify and improve health service delivery. This will help address population health issues, socio-economic challenges.

What will this research involve:

- Household survey: we will conduct a once off face to face interview and two telephonic interviews per year, with a household member who will tell us about the entire household
- Individual survey: an interview will be conducted with individual household members. This will be done during one visit per year
- Health monitoring: HIV, height, weight and blood pressure testing will be done and results will be shared with you

Surveys will include questions about:

- Residence status, migrations births and deaths
- Education status
- Immunizations
- Food security
- Employment
- Housing, asset ownership
- Vehicle ownership
- Access to energy, water and sanitation

If a household member has passed away, the care giver or close relative will be asked questions about this

Linkage to service delivery data

We will also link you and your household members to existing service delivery data to understand individual and population level access to services

Who will take part?

Families and individuals residing in Atteridgeville and Melusi who are

- Willing to provide written consent to participate,
- Able to provide a form of identification
- Willing to take part in study procedures

Who will do the survey with you?

It will be done by qualified and trained staff and your data will be kept confidential

What if you don't want to take part?

You and anyone in your household will be free to refuse to participate in the survey, and to withdraw from the study at any time, without any impact on routine health care or other services to which you are entitled
